New Commercial Distribution Rates

Effective May 1, 2009



The changes...

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB), responsible for regulating the distribution rates of utilities across the Province, has given approval to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. ("Hydro One Brampton") for an adjustment to our distribution rates. The distribution rate changes will affect the "Delivery" line of your electricity bill, effective May 1, 2009, which covers Hydro One Brampton's costs to deliver electricity to businesses in Brampton.

These adjustments to Hydro One Brampton's distribution rates impact the monthly service and volumetric charges.

Your new distribution rates are as follows:

(General Service - less than 50 kW)

The monthly service charge will increase from \$21.20 to \$21.64 and the distribution volumetric rate will remain unchanged at \$0.0181 per kilowatt-hour. The transmission network rate will increase from \$0.0043 to \$0.0048 per kilowatt-hour and the transmission connection rate will increase from \$0.0040 to \$0.0042 per kilowatt-hour. Other non-competitive electricity charges will increase from \$0.0062 to \$0.0065 per kilowatt-hour.

(General Service - 50 kW to 699 kW)

The monthly service charge will increase from \$104.02 to \$104.53 and the distribution volumetric rate will increase from \$2.3333 to \$2.3354 per kilowatt. The transmission network rate will increase from \$1.6567 to \$1.8432 per kilowatt and the transmission connection rate will increase from \$1.5209 to \$1.6134 per kilowatt. Other non-competitive electricity charges will increase from \$0.0062 to \$0.0065 per kilowatt-hour.

(General Service - 700 kW to 4999 kW)

The monthly service charge will increase from \$1,435.50 to \$1,437.21 and the distribution volumetric rate will increase from \$3.8003 to \$3.8037 per kilowatt. The transmission network rate will increase from \$1.8580 to \$2.0671 per kilowatt and the transmission connection rate will increase from \$1.6349 to \$1.7343 per kilowatt. Other non-competitive electricity charges will increase from \$0.0062 to \$0.0065 per kilowatt-hour.

(Large Use - greater than 5000 kW)

The monthly service charge will increase from \$4,804.82 to \$4,809.57 and the distribution volumetric rate will increase from \$2.9526 to \$2.9553 per kilowatt. The transmission network rate will increase from \$2.1028 to \$2.3395 per kilowatt and the transmission connection rate will increase from \$1.8897 to \$2.0046 per kilowatt. Other non-competitive electricity charges will increase from \$0.0062 to \$0.0065 per kilowatt-hour.
