#### **Why Change To Smart Meters?**

Your old electricity meter was only capable of measuring the total amount of electricity you used over an entire billing period, and it had to be read manually.

Your new Smart Meter automatically tracks, records and sends your electricity consumption, on an hourly basis, to Hydro One Brampton through wireless technology.

With this newer technology, along with the implementation of Time-Of-Use rates, you will be able to monitor and manage your electricity costs, while helping to reduce the impact that on-peak electricity generation can have on the environment.

#### **What is Time-Of-Use (TOU) Pricing?**

Time-Of-Use prices vary throughout the day, depending on electricity demand and availability of supply.

Under the current Regulated Price Plan (RPP), the price you pay for electricity is the same no matter what time of day you use it. This leaves very little financial incentive to consumers to shift their usage to off-peak times of the day.

With rates that fluctuate at varying peak demand times in a 24-hour period, you will have the opportunity to change your electricity usage to off-peak times when electricity is least expensive.

***NOTE: Hydro One Brampton customers will receive advance notification of when TOU rates will come into effect.***
